Dear Students and Parents:

I would like to congratulate you for taking the opportunity to register for college credit through the FACES program (Formation through Advanced Catholic Education and Scholarship). This is an excellent way to get a head start on college and prepare for your future career. By meeting or exceeding the standards asked for by our cooperating colleges and universities, students will be able to earn college or university credits for courses taken at Geibel.

Important: Each of these schools has its own registration procedures and requirements for earning credits. Please read the information provided by each carefully, and contact us if you have any questions.

Registration Procedures for Seton Hill:

1. Obtain the registration form from the Geibel website, parent email, or request a copy from the front office.

2. Complete the registration form. Remit the proper amount of payment (\$220/course). You may enclose a check made out to Seton Hill University or place your credit card information on the form.
3. Enclose your registration form and payment in a secure envelope. On the front of the envelope clearly print your child's name, and the college or university to which you are applying.
4. Submit the completed registration form to the office no later than Friday, September 17, 2010. No applications will be accepted after this date.
5. Upon completion of the course, transcripts may be obtained at www.setonhill.edu, or by calling the registrar at Seton Hill University: (724) 838-4218.

Registration Procedures for Saint Vincent College:

1. Obtain the registration form(s) from the Geibel website, parent email, or request a copy from the front office for the desired St. Vincent College course(s) that your child wishes to register for. Each course has a separate registration form.
2. Complete the registration form(s). Remit the proper amount of payment in the form of a check payable to Saint Vincent College. The cost of registration is \$65/credit, plus a \$15.00 one-time initial registration fee.
3. Enclose your registration form(s) and check in a secure envelope to be returned to the front office. Clearly print on the envelope your child's name, and the college or university to which you are applying.
4. All registration materials are due in the office by October 8, 2010. No applications will be accepted after this date.
5. Instructions for transcript requests may be found at www.stvincent.edu.

Registration Procedures for Mount Aloysius College:[†]

1. Review the sample registration form provided with your application packet. Use this as a guide for filling out a blank form for the course(s) you want.
2. Courses cost \$35/credit plus a \$20 registration fee. Include your credit card information on the bottom of the form, or enclose a check for the proper amount payable to Mount Aloysius College.
3. Place your application materials in a secure envelope. On the envelope print your child's name and the college or university to which you are applying.
4. The due date for this college application will be announced in the near future.
5. A transcript request form is included with your packet.

Transferring Credits:

Transferring any or all of these credits to another institution is entirely at the discretion of that institution. Other schools may accept all, some or none of the credits. If you plan to

[†] In order to register for credit with Mount Aloysius, a student must be a junior or senior. No exceptions. Students must also maintain a 2.0 average in the course, and a 3.0 average in the applicable area of study.


transfer credits earned through this program, you should check with the college or university to which you want to transfer them in order to see if they will accept them.

All credit transfers are done entirely through the colleges and universities. Geibel is not involved in this process. Check with the university or college to which you are transferring credit for their policies and procedures.
