First Quarter Report Cards

Starting this year, Document Delivery of your child's report card is mandatory. The steps to having that happen are VERY EASY. The attachment, within the newsletter, will walk you through the process. One part of this process is to set up a password so that only you can see the grades. **You would only need to put in a password IF** you have other people who have access to your email and you prefer they do not see the grades. If you can avoid setting up a password, it is highly recommended since most people do not have others sharing your email. Your password for Power School is different from Document Delivery so that tends to confuse people. It is better just to have the one password for Power School. 


Parent Opt In for PowerSchool Digital Document Delivery.

- 3. Select the Document Delivery tab
 - a. Check the Opt-In box
 - b. Enter the email address where you would like to receive your report cards. You can enter more than one address separated by commas (,)
 - c. Enter a password. You will be prompted to enter this password when you get the report card in order to view it. If you do not set a PDF password anyone with access to the document email that is sent will be able to view the report card.
