#### EVERYDAY STEWARDSHIP - RECOGNIZE GOD IN YOUR ORDINARY MOMENTS

Rise, and Go to Your Father

"If you pull into my driveway and honk, you better be dropping off a package, because you're sure not picking anything up."

I first read these words in the pages of W. Bruce Cameron's "8 Simple Rules for Dating my Teenage Daughter," (that's Rule No. 5, by the way).

There's a certain respect that is shown by someone who takes the time to come to the door, ring the bell and wait to be greeted. Being willing to go through the niceties for the sake of appearances is a small act of deference on the part of the person doing the picking-up, even if it's not for a date. Without it, the whole scenario becomes entitled.

I want you to think of something that you want or need, but do not have. Is it peace? Is it financial stability? Is it strength? Is it friendship?

The brother of the prodigal son had a lot of unexpressed desires. He sees his brother heaped with gifts and favors, feasting on the fattened calf, and he is enraged. I haven't been given half of that, he thinks, and I've worked so hard.

But for all his faithfulness, one has to wonder - did this son ever simply ask for what he needed? Did he get out of the car, so to speak, and ring the bell? Or did he sit in the driveway leaning on the horn?

God wants us to come before Him. He wants us to ask. He wants us to be like Moses — sure enough of our Father's indulgence to boldly ask for it. Think again about what you need but do not have, and ask yourself: Have I approached the door and rung the bell?

### Students not feeling well/Contacting Parents for pick up:

If a student becomes ill during the school day, the student must obtain a pass from the classroom teacher before reporting to the Office. If the student fails to do this, the absence will be recorded as a class cut, and penalized accordingly. Students are not to stay out of class or remain in a lavatory.

If a student is too ill to stay in school, they need to report to the Main Office, where they will call parents to arrange for students to go home. The student is not permitted to call parent or guardian on his/her own and have them call the Main Office. Please note that by them attempting to contact you on your cell phone, they are putting themselves in a position of violating the discipline code and they will have to face necessary consequences.








## PIE THE PRINCIPAL!

Sundae Toppings available to add to the pies for \$1 per topping!




# The Math Lab is OPEN Providing Auxiliary Support Services

The Math Lab is a resource provided to Geibel Catholic Jr./Sr. high school students by Catapult Learning. The following services are funded through the federal EANS (Emergency Assistance to Non-public Schools) program and allocated by the Intermediate Unit 1. The IU contracts with Catapult Learning to provide a certified teacher to the school for auxiliary instructional time, at no cost to the students.

Open Monday through Thursday, periods 2 – 9, the Math Lab, adjacent to the gymnasium in room 113, offers homework support, test preparation, and supplemental instruction in all areas of Mathematics from Prealgebra through Calculus. Assistance and resources are also available to prepare for SAT/ACT exams or other math placement tests. Students may come to the lab on their own volition from their study halls, or may be referred by their math teacher, guidance counselor, or administrator. Additional times can always be arranged upon request. 
