Lunch for Gator Walk:

The menu for the day will be: Hamburger, Hot Dogs, Potato Salad, Chips/Pretzels, and Cookies. Lunch is included with the day's activities. If your student decides that they do not want the lunch, they are more than welcome to pack. Please have them drop it in the office, at the beginning of the day, and we will make sure that it gets up to the field. They can be dropped off in the Main Office.

Kona Ice:


