GENERAL INFORMATION FOR PARENTS/GUARDIANS AND STUDENTS

TICKETS (DUE MONDAY APRIL 1, 2023)

Ticket cost is \$150.00 per boy/girl couple or \$75.00 for a single. Tickets will be on sale from March 13th through April 1th in Mr. Procko's room. **ONLY CHECKS WILL BE ACCEPTED.** All checks should be made payable to "Geibel Catholic."

Ticket cost covers dinner and dancing at The Stone House Inn in Farmington, PA and unlimited use of the photo booth. Formal portraits will be taken by Gerard Photography for an additional cost.

PROM DRESS GUIDELINES

As per administration of Geibel Catholic, girls' dresses are to be modest, be within the boundaries of Catholic moral principles, and adhere to the following guidelines:

FEMALES:

- Skintight or suggestive dresses are not permitted.
- Strapless dresses are permitted as long as undergarments are covered.
- Transparent material is not permitted on the bodice or skirt of the dress.
- No transparent cutouts are permitted on the front or sides of the dress.
- The back of the dress cannot fall below the natural waistline which is around your belly button.
- Midriffs must be covered
- No portion of the dress should be shorter than mid-thigh.
- Tasteful/dressy pantsuits are also permitted.
- Foot coverings (socks, flip flops, ballet flats) must always be worn.

MALES:

- Boys are expected to wear a suit or tuxedo, a shirt and tie, and dress socks and shoes.
- Boys must keep their shirts on at all times.

FORMAL PORTRAITS

Formal portraits will be taken by Gerard Photography at The Stone House. Envelopes from the studio are included in this packet and may be returned in this packet. Picture prices are indicated on the outside of the envelope. Please include payment inside the photographer's envelope.

TRANSPORTATION

All students are expected to transport themselves to and from the venue whether by themselves, with another couple, or with their parents. This choice must be selected on the appropriate permission slip.

DANCING and APPROPRIATE LANGUAGE

Students are reminded that dancing should be appropriate for students in a Catholic school. Students dancing inappropriately will be reprimanded by the chaperones. Students are also reminded to refrain from singing the lyrics to songs whose unedited versions contain explicit and/or vulgar language.

USE OF ALCOHOL AND/OR DRUGS

Absolutely no alcohol or drugs are permitted during The Grand March or Prom. Absolutely no smoking or use of tobacco in any form is permitted during The Grand March or Prom. If any student is suspected of being under the influence of alcohol or drugs, he/she will be escorted from the Grand March or Prom by security, at which time his/her parents/guardians will be notified as well as the police.

JUNIOR LICENSE

YOUNG DRIVERS WHO GRADUATE TO A JUNIOR LICENSE HAVE SATISFACTORILY COMPLETED ALL LEARNER'S PERMIT REQUIREMENTS, INCLUDING THE ROAD TEST, BUT THE FOLLOWING RESTRICTIONS STILL APPLY:

- A young driver's junior license will be suspended for 90 days if he or she accumulates six or more points or is convicted of a single high-speed violation (driving 26 miles per hour or more over the posted speed limit).
- Even with a junior license, a young driver may not be behind the wheel between the hours of 11 p.m. and 5 a.m. Exceptions for employment and volunteer or charitable service will apply, but young drivers must carry proper documentation regarding their need to travel.
- The number of passengers must not exceed the number of seat belts in the vehicle, and all seatbelts must be worn. This applies to all passengers and drivers under the age of 18.
