FACTS Financial Aid Information:

NEW THIS YEAR! Families who want to apply for financial aid for their students for the 2023–24 school year will only be required to use their 2021 tax returns and not their 2022 tax returns. Returning families will already have the 2021 tax returns on file with FACTS so no new uploads for those documents are needed! W-2s are not needed. (If there is a scenario where a using the 2022 tax return is beneficial to the family, the 2022 tax return can be uploaded once the forms are ready and FACTS will recalculate need.) The financial aid application for 23–24 school year must be completed.
