Mrs. Vittorio's Supply Lists:

Math Classes: 3 ring binder, pencils, eraser, highlighter, & ruler is optional. Students in more than one of her math classes may use the same binder, but then the binder must be a 2in or 3in.

Mrs. Cline's Supply List:

Introduction to Engineering: Notebook (3-ring binder preferred, with lined paper), Pencil/Pen, Colored Pencils (suggested)

CHS Human Anatomy & Physiology: 3 inch 3-ring binder, Pencil/Pen, Colored Pencils, & 300 index cards (preferably attached with a ring)

Dr. Stevenson's Supply List:

Notebook: Hardcopy (single subject) or Electronic (School issued laptop: MS Word, MS Notes, etc.), Writing utensils (pencils recommended), Folder (Manilla, single pocket, etc.)
