#### **Dress Down Days:**

Friday, September 22nd is our first Dress Down day of the year! Whoo! Hoo! This year, dress down days will cost \$3/day or a bundle package of \$25. The bundle package will cover every dress down day, that happens during the 2023-2024 school year. If you choose to pay for each dress down day individually, the monies are always due the day of or the Wednesday prior to the next dress down day. October's dress down day will be October 17th. Below is the dress code, for review. We ask that you please ensure that your children adhere to it. If they do not, they will run the risk of losing Dress Down privileges.

Page 57 & 58 in the Geibel Parent Student Handbook: CLOTHING FOR ALTERNATE DRESS DAYS Clothing for Dress Down Days is to be appropriate, neat, clean, and of proper fit and length. Jeans and Capri pants are acceptable if they are not too tight, low rise, or ripped/torn. Short length to 3 inches above the top of the knee is acceptable. Skirts and dresses should be no shorter than 3 inches above the top of the knee. Tight or suggestive clothes, sleeveless shirts, halter tops, low cut shirts, exposed midriff, pajama bottoms, flannel pants, yoga pants, leggings, short dresses/skirts (even with tights), and hats/head gear of any kind are NOT permitted.

**Location:** Geibel Catholic Junior-Senior High School

**Date:** Wednesday, October 11, 2023

<u>Time:</u> Testing will begin after morning prayer.

**Registration:** Bring payment of \$15 (cash and checks are acceptable-please make checks payable to Geibel Catholic) in an envelope to guidance by Tuesday, October 10, 2023. PLEASE, put your name and grade on the envelope.

-STUDENT GUIDE FOR PSAT 8/9 and PSAT NMSQT are available online and will be sent to students and parents via email.

#### WHAT SHOULD YOU BRING?

Computer and Charger

An acceptable calculator for use on the Math section of the test (there will be an embedded graphing calculator available to use within Bluebook)

Pen or Pencil

Epinephrine auto-injectors (like EpiPens) are permitted without an approved accommodation. They must be placed in a clear bag and stored under the student's desk during testing.

#### THINGS TO KNOW PRIOR TO TEST DAY:

All PSAT tests are digital and taken through the Bluebook app.

**Test Format:** The reading and writing section of the PSAT consists of 54 questions divided into 2 modules. The Math section consists of 44 questions divided into 2 modules. An acceptable calculator can be used on the entire Math section of the test.

Get a good night's sleep before the test and eat a nutritious breakfast!
