

Junior Class Ring Ceremony:

The Junior Class Ring Ceremony will be Monday, January 29th, 2024, during Catholic Schools Week and will take place during a 9:00 am Mass on that day celebrated by our Bishop Kulick.

It is tradition at Geibel Catholic that the Junior Class holds a Ring Ceremony, which stemmed from the time when nearly every student would purchase a class ring. Over time, the preference to purchase a class ring has shifted, and not all students desire to buy one. However, the Ring Ceremony also serves as a "rite of passage" to the Junior Class as the future leaders of the school. For that reason, we want to continue the tradition at Geibel Catholic to help celebrate the Junior Class's accomplishments and what lies ahead.

We want all Junior students to participate in this ceremony, and so are requesting a little help from home.

Here are ways that you can help your child prepare:

1. Please help your child **choose a piece of jewelry** if he/she did not order a class ring. It could be another ring, necklace, bracelet, or some other piece of jewelry that perhaps holds special significance. In the past, students have used Mother's rings, dog tags from a veteran family member, and pieces of jewelry that have already been given to them as gifts from loved ones. Please do not feel the need to go out and purchase anything new for this event.

2. Once a piece of jewelry is chosen, please put it in a small jewelry gift box and **write your child's name on the bottom of the box**. Should you not have a small jewelry gift box, please put the piece in a Ziplock sandwich baggie and write your child's name on the bag.

3. Please send the piece of jewelry to the school office with your child **by THURSDAY, JANUARY 25.** and it will be placed in the locked school safe.

4. If your child has already ordered a class ring, it is at school locked in the school safe.

5. Prior to the ceremony, the jewelry items will be placed in small gift bags and placed on a table.

6. During the ceremony, the pieces of jewelry will be blessed by Bishop Kulick before the presentation. After the blessing,

the Junior Class will be presented with the gift bag containing the piece of jewelry.

7. Once the student returns to his/her seat, he/she will be welcome to take the piece out to wear.

8. Additionally, your Junior Class student is welcome to wear <u>"dress-up" clothing</u> that would follow the dress code. This is an event that is taking place within a Mass <u>with the Bishop pre-</u> <u>sent</u>, so classy is the theme. Proper dresses, skirts, or dress slacks should be worn by our ladies, and dress pants, button-down dress shirts, and ties should be worn by our gentlemen. Parents, please help them select a suitable outfit for the day that represents your family and our school well, as you will also have the opportunity for nice pictures.

Please know that Junior Class families are welcome to attend, as are all families!
